

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS January 1, 2018 – March 31, 2018

FORMOLI, WALEED A - RCP 36052

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a prior arrest for public intoxication. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective January 26, 2018.

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MARTAK, MICHAEL CJ - RCP 7798

Convicted of possession of a controlled substance. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective January 26, 2018.

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PEREZ, ASHLEY LUISA - RCP 30558

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to notify the Board of her arrest for driving under the influence of alcohol and willful cruelty to a child and failing to pay probation monitoring fees and cost recovery. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective January 29, 2018.

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DENEAR, CATHRYN ANN - RCP 20361

Obtaining, using, and possession of a controlled substance and convicted of driving under the influence of a drug. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective February 7, 2018.

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KNIGHT, ROBERT G - RCP 12152

Committed acts of negligence by failing to maintain a record of the original critical ABG values, failing to obtain a second ABG sample from a patient, and manually entering alternate non-critical ABG values. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, license surrendered effective February 17, 2018.

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LANSANGAN, HERNANDO S - RCP 13629

Committed acts of negligence by documenting weaning trails that were not performed and failing to follow a physician's orders to perform daily weaning attempts. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective February 18, 2018. View Documents

EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Roard

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

WHITING, DOUGLAS-RCP 37729

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with two prior convictions for driving under the influence of alcohol. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective March 15, 2018.

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AZUSADA, RAYMOND - RCP 36733

Failed to comply with Board-ordered probation by failing to check in daily for biological fluid testing, testing positive for cannabinoids, and failing to pay probation monitoring fees. Pursuant to a Decision proposed by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked effective March 22, 2018.

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JESSUP, KATHERINE LOVINA - RCP 29309

Committed acts of negligence and unprofessional conduct by failing to provide timely treatments for multiple patients, failing to perform an oxygen check, failing to assess a patient to determine if ordered therapy was needed, failing to provide ordered oxygen therapy, and failing to respond for an albuterol treatment, failing to complete and/or making grossly incorrect or inconsistent charting records. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective March 28, 2018.

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
