

DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

April 1, 2025 - June 30, 2025

BOCANEGRA RUBIO, SOPHIA – RCP 45215

Convicted of public intoxication and driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective April 16, 2025.

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ORELLANA, JAIDA JASMINE - RCP 38346

Convicted of disorderly conduct which involved the use of alcohol with disciplinary considerations for prior offenses. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective May 8, 2025.

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ESTRADA, TAMI RENE - RCP 29906

Committed negligence, unprofessional conduct, and administered unsafe respiratory care when refusing to provide treatment to a patient without delay, failing to act promptly without delay, failing to provide any documentation in the medical records of a patient, and failing to carry out, promptly and without delay, a standing physician's orders. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective May 14, 2025.

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GONZALEZ, GEORGE - RCP 27033

Committed negligence, unprofessional conduct, and fraudulent and dishonest acts in his care and treatment of a patient when falsely documenting and altering a patient's medical records and failing to follow policy and procedure regarding a tracheotomy change. Prior Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, revoked license, stayed revocation, and placed Respondent on two (2) years' probation. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on four (4) years' probation effective May 23, 2025.

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EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

MATA, SIMON C. - RCP 29344

Violated terms and conditions of probation when Respondent tested positive for alcohol biomarkers. Prior order issued by the Board, granted reinstatement, immediately revoking license, staying revocation, and placing Respondent on three (3) years' probation. Pursuant to a Proposed Decision by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked effective June 10, 2025.

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
