



DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

April 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

HANEY, JENNIFER MICHELLE – RCP 32037

Committed a fraudulent, dishonest, or corrupt act that is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a respiratory care practitioner; administered unsafe respiratory care; engaged in unprofessional conduct and negligent acts falsifying or making grossly incorrect hospital timesheet entries; and committed negligence in that she neglected a patient, failed to provide accurate, timely, truthful, and thorough documentation of multiple patients, and failed to provide and document any care to a patient during an entire shift. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective April 1, 2026.

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ROJAS, AMY NICOLE – RCP 39962

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08 or more causing great bodily injury. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective April 13, 2026.

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HERNANDEZ, LOURDES C. – RCP 43160

Violated terms and conditions of probation when testing positive for alcohol biomarkers. Pursuant to a Default Decision and Order, license revoked effective April 15, 2026.

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LYNCH, RODNEY – RCP 35459

Committed fraudulent, dishonest, or corrupt acts that are substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a respiratory care practitioner; falsified, or made grossly incorrect, grossly inconsistent, or unintelligible entries in a patient, hospital, or other record; committed negligence and administered unsafe respiratory care procedures, protocols, therapeutic regimens, or diagnostic testing or monitoring techniques in that he failed to provide care and treatments to several patients and documented that he provided said care and treatments when he in fact did not. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective April 16, 2026.

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EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

RODRIGUEZ, CHRISTINA ROSE – RCP 19650

Worked in a health care profession or environment under the influence of alcohol and used alcoholic beverages to an extent or in a manner dangerous or injurious to herself or to others, or that it impaired her ability to conduct, with safety, the practice authorized by her license. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective April 17, 2026.

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DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

April 1, 2026 – June 30, 2026

ANAYA, STACY LYNN – RCP 21464

Prior conviction for recklessly driving a motor vehicle under the influence of alcohol. Used a controlled substance, to wit: fentanyl without a valid prescription and to an extent or in a manner dangerous or injurious to herself or others, or that impaired her ability to conduct with safety the practice authorized by her license. Pursuant to a Proposed Decision by an Administrative Law Judge, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective April 22, 2026.

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HANSCOM, MIA – RCP 38892

Committed negligence in her practice as a RCP, falsified, or made grossly incorrect, grossly inconsistent, or unintelligible entries in any patient, hospital, or other record, and administered unsafe respiratory care procedures, protocols, therapeutic regimens, or diagnostic testing or monitoring techniques in that she modified a patient's ventilator settings without a physician's authorization, failed to accurately document a patient's ventilator settings, and stored a patient's medications in her personal locker against hospital policy. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective May 7, 2026.

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BENNETT, DEBBAN LYNN – RCP 16570

Convicted of driving under the influence of alcohol and willful cruelty to a child. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective May 7, 2026.

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
