



DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

October 1, 2025 – December 31, 2025

FISCAL, SILAS JONATHAN – RCP 45387

Committed negligence, unprofessional conduct, and falsified and/or made grossly incorrect entries in a record when he extubated the wrong patient, failed to verify a patient's identity before performing an important medical procedure, and submitted an order for the extubation of a patient without authorization from a physician. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective October 2, 2025.

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KUMEROW, DANIELLE M. – RCP 37305

Convicted of second-degree commercial burglary and possession for sale of a controlled substance. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective October 11, 2025.

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MACIEL, CECILIA ESPINOZA – RCP 30625

Convicted of a felony count of driving under the influence of alcohol with a blood alcohol content of 0.08% or higher, causing injury, with disciplinary consideration for a prior offense. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective October 23, 2025.

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CUSTODIO, ARIEL – RCP 15900

Committed negligence and administered unsafe respiratory care procedures when he changed a trach tube without a physician's orders. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective November 9, 2025.

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BARSCZ, SUSAN ANNE – RCP 14412

Prior surrendered license based on failure to comply with terms and conditions of probation, with discipline consideration for a prior offense. Pursuant to an order issued by the Board, reinstatement of license granted, license immediately revoked, stayed, and placed on two (2) years' probation effective November 19, 2025.

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EXPLANATION OF DISCIPLINARY LANGUAGE AND ACTIONS

Effective date of decision: The date the disciplinary decision goes into operation.

Default Decision: A decision based on the licensee's failure to respond to formal charges after it has been served, or failure to appear at an Administrative Hearing. All charges are deemed true. The decision results in the revocation of the license.

Disciplinary Order: An order for discipline adopted by the Board.

Probation: Allows the licensee to practice as a respiratory care practitioner under terms and conditions for a set amount of time.

Proposed Decision: A decision rendered by an Administrative Law Judge through an Administrative Hearing. A proposed decision must be adopted by the Board before it can go into effect.

Revoked: The right to practice is ended due to disciplinary action. The license is invalidated, voided, annulled, or rescinded. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

Revoked, Stayed: "Stayed" means the revocation is postponed. Professional practice may continue so long as the licensee complies with specified terms and conditions of probation.

Stipulated Settlement: A form of plea bargaining. The case is formally negotiated and settled prior to a hearing.

Stipulated Surrendered: The Board agrees to allow the licensee to surrender the license as a resolution to a disciplinary matter. The individual can no longer practice as a respiratory care practitioner in California.

DE JESUS, ADRIANA – RCP 26616

Committed negligence, administered unsafe respiratory care procedures, and engaged in fraudulent, dishonest, and/or corrupt act substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of a Respiratory Care Practitioner when she failed to ensure a ventilator was turned on, failed to properly assess a patient, failed to appropriately and timely chart ventilation notes, and falsely noted that she checked on a patient. Pursuant to a Stipulated Surrender of License and Disciplinary Order, license surrendered effective November 24, 2025.

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DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

CHAVEZ, KIMBERLY AURORA – RCP 40633

Committed negligence and administered unsafe respiratory care procedures, protocols, therapeutic regimens, or diagnostic testing or monitoring techniques when she missed ordered treatments and failed to timely document checks and assessments, as well as charted outside of the two-hour window required by her employer without any justifiable excuse. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective December 5, 2025.

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BANUELOS, JUAN A. – RCP 37634

Committed negligence and administered unsafe respiratory care procedures, protocols, therapeutic regimens, or diagnostic testing or monitoring techniques when he missed ordered treatments and failed to timely document checks and assessments. Pursuant to a Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, license revoked, stayed, and placed on three (3) years' probation effective December 5, 2025.

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
